(Board Response: We looked at the official rule and it qualifies as a hazard and the office will send the member a letter.)

Open Floor

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Tony Harris Brought up rule change that is needed. In our Covenants, Bylaws & Rules, under Part III, Rules-Administrative-Collections "a fee of \$75.00 will be assessed per lien filing instance." We need to update that to \$250. to offset price increases in charges for filing liens.

Jennifer Halverson (1829) Asked if the east deck is bad enough that it should be roped off until the repairs can be made. **(Board Response:** The east deck should be roped off until repairs can be made and to mark/place caution tape at the potential hazards at Cedar Beach until repairs can be made. Also asked office to mention the Cedar Beach and east deck repairs on the association website and Facebook page to alert members of the dangers and upcoming repairs.) **Bob Jennings (497)** Addressed the board about a 30 by 40 shed by the lake and questioned whether the gravel foundation and metal material was according to the code. Bob also had concerns about the run off of water off of the newly built shed. Conversation ensues. **Angie Webster** We pulled the permit and it was submitted as a gravel foundation and we also looked at the building code for Madison County and a gravel base is considered acceptable as a foundation. A Madison County and Holishor permit was obtained from the member, and both have been closed. **Eric Jennings (399)** Asked for clarification of several of the building rules. Conversation ensues.
