

1 Corinthians 15:3-8, 12-23

Manager's Report by Angie Webster



Spring is around the corner, and we will be going into the typical rainy season (fingers crossed) The lake remains around 30" below full pool at press time. Rain has brought it up a little, we need a lot more rainfall, or one big rain to fill it. Be mindful of applying fertilizers or herbicides that you stay 25' minimum from waters edge. Round up does make a "Aquatic friendly" spray. Remember to spray on dry days when there is no rain in the forecast.

Spring is also a great time of year to get out and start cleaning up our property. Yard waste pick up starts back up on April 2nd. If you haven't done so you can order a free yard waste tote from republic. The yard waste tote is awesome as it keeps the debris from getting wet. Sometimes the brown paper bags get wet, rip and are less effective. You may also burn your yard waste sunrise to sunset. Keep an eye on our Facebook, Safety page and website. Madison County has started a new program allowing Fire Chiefs to call for a no burn day in their district due to weather conditions. We will be working directly with Jim O'Brien, Holiday Shores Fire Chief, to help with getting this out to the residents.

On that note, we have had several instances of lumber, and other construction materials being burned. This is an EPA violation. EPA can issue some steep fines for this.

The second installment of Dues and assessments was due March 1st. Members who may have difficulty staying current with this requirement should contact the office and communicate any special needs with us. Communication with the Office is a key factor and could save us all added expenses and frustration.

It's always nice to see the outdoor activity increase in our community. One of these is walking our dogs. Please remember Madison County does have a leash law. If your pet makes a mess, please be respectful of others property and clean up any waste. Please watch your speed through the neighborhood, we have children out and about in the community.

Reminder, there will be three open positions for Board of Director this year.

Candidate packets are available in the office or on our website. Completed packets must be submitted to the office no later than April 5th by close of business.

GOT DECALS? 2025 Decals Expire April 30, 2025

Lot numbers and 2026 decals need to be present on ALL watercraft including watercraft on lifts and non-highway vehicles before May 1, 2026.

This includes all non-motorized watercraft (kayaks, canoes, paddle-boards & paddle-boats). 2026 dues & assessments must be paid in full and you must provide your current watercraft registration and proof of \$300,000 liability insurance on the watercraft to receive your motorized watercraft decals.

Non-highway Vehicle decals are \$15 annually.

The state requires driver to have a valid driver's license and liability insurance coverage be carried within the vehicle.



Happy Spring Holiday Shores, it's April and the lake is beginning to fill up from the winter draw down. That means it's that fun time of the year when the abundant crappie are shallow and easier to find and catch. They can be located and caught in most of the docks, along seawalls, and rocks. Lures of choice are typically 1.5 or 2-inch crappie jigs. Remember there is still no limit on them and due to the efforts of the community, their size is noticeably increasing. These are highly considered one of the tastiest fish to eat, and they can also make great fertilizer for your flower beds or gardens if you don't want to eat them. Spring is also a great time to get kids involved in fishing since there are plenty of them in our lake and they are easier to catch. Please remember when you launch your boat to lock the cable back up on the ramp. No need to have NON MEMBERS enjoying what we pay for! Remember to have your boat stickers on your boat by May 1st so you don't receive a fine. Also don't forget those associate member cards for your guests using your boats and enjoying the lake. The fishing committee has a raffle to help fund our stocking for the lake and we currently have tickets for sale!
