Holiday Shores Waste Disposal Services

Republic Services is contracted to provide waste disposal services. Please contact them at (618) 656-6883 to establish service. Republic Services provides **weekly** collection of regular household trash and provides an **every-other-week** collection of recycle materials. Republic Services provides a cart for trash and a cart for recycle materials; therefore, personal containers are prohibited for trash and recycle. Trash and recycle material must be contained inside the carts. Reminder, trash and recycle materials cannot be mixed together. **Please have carts to the curb on service day by 6 a.m.**

Republic Services also provides weekly yard waste collection during the months of April through December. **A maximum of 8 containers are allowed with the weekly service.** Acceptable containers for yard waste are kraft paper biodegradable bags or a 32 gallon personal trash container marked with a red "x." Containers of yard waste cannot exceed 50lbs each. Sticks and twigs up to 4" diameter will be collected in 2x4 bundles tied with string/twine. 95 gallon containers for yard waste are also available to lease upon request.

Republic Services recognizes six holidays; New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day. PLEASE NOTE: There will be no pick-up on these holidays. Should your pick-up day fall on or after the holiday, your trash, recycle and yard waste will be collected one day late.

Republic Services will provide a spring clean-up of large items and appliances for residents on the next scheduled trash pickup after the June annual yard sale. Large items include furniture, mattress sets and large carpets (cut into manageable bundles no longer than 4ft. and weighing no more than 50lbs each.) Glass portions of doors, windows, etc. should be broken and placed into a small box marked "glass." Electronic waste (including televisions) as well as concrete, shingles, construction debris/home remodeling construction debris of any kind, tires, yard waste (including tree stumps) and railroad ties are prohibited. Loose materials or materials in cardboard boxes will not be serviced, as all items must be bagged and contained. All items must be set curbside by 6am.

To schedule a large item pick up outside of the spring clean up date, please contact Republic Services.

PROPER CONTAINER PLACEMENT

- Have the container **at the curb by 6:00 a.m.** of your collection day. Carts placed in alleys will not be serviced.
- Place the container at least five feet from any object; like a tree, pole, fire hydrant, mailbox, electrical box, cable box, etc. and at least five feet away from cars so the automated arm can reach your container.
- Please have the same distance of five feet between waste and recycle containers.
- Don't lean anything against the container.
- Don't place your container under a tree or near utility lines.
- Place containers one foot from the curb or edge of the street.
- Remember to place the arrows on the lid of the container toward the street and the handle toward your house, with the lid closed.

Proper Cart Placement is the Key to Automated Service



For safety reasons, please do not allow children to play in or around the containers. Republic Services trucks use mechanical arms to pick up the waste and recycle containers.

Acceptable items included in large item pickups:

ACCEPTABLE BULK ITEMS

- Ø Carpet: cut into bundles no longer than 4' in length and 2' in diameter and weighing less than 50 lbs. per bundle
- Ø Furniture: couches, chairs, dressers, tables, desks, etc.
- Ø Glass portions of doors/windows: must be broken down and placed into small box marked "glass".
- Ø Mattress sets and box springs: (must be wrapped in plastic with ends wrapped/taped closed.)
- Ø Appliances
- Ø Basketball sets/poles, unless they are broken down into section! and no larger than 3' in diameter.



UNACCEPTABLE BULK ITEMS

- Ø Batteries
- Ø Concrete and construction material of any kind
- Ø Electronic waste: televisions, computer monitors/accessories, Mp3 players, DVD/VCRs etc.
- Ø Fluorescent light bulbs
- Ø Lead/oil-based paint/varnish
- Ø Loose trash or trash in cardboard boxes
- Ø Tires
- Ø Yard waste and Pool heaters

CLEAN UP GUIDELINES (HOUSEHOLD ITEMS ONLY)

Items included in Bulk Pickup:

- Furniture
 - Couches, chairs, dressers, tables, bookshelves, desks, headboards, etc.
- Mattress sets and Box Springs. **(must be wrapped in plastic with ends wrapped/taped closed.)**
- Large carpets (cut into bundles no longer than 4ft in length and 2 ft in diameter and not to exceed 50lbs. Must be tied with string/twine.) 5 rolls of carpet is considered 1 item.
- Appliances.
- Misc. yard appliances (weed eater, push lawnmower- **must remove gas & liquids before disposal.**)
- Glass portions of doors, windows, etc. NOTE: These must be broken and placed into a small box marked "glass."
- All nails/staples or anything sharp that is exposed must be removed to prevent injury to you and the collector.
- Basketball sets/poles: NOTE: These must be broken down/cut into 4ft. sections and no larger than 3" in diameter.

Items not included in Bulk Pickup:

- Construction debris of any kind
 - Shingles, drywall, vinyl siding, molding/trim, fencing, kitchen cabinets, etc.
- Loose trash or trash in cardboard boxes.
- Basketball sets/poles, unless they are broken down into 4ft. sections and no larger than 3" in diameter.
- Concrete.
- Tires.
- Lead/oil based paint, varnish.
- Batteries.
- Yard waste.
- Fluorescent light bulbs.
- Any other items not listed identified as hazardous waste.
- Electronic Waste – due to IL state law, electronics cannot be disposed of in a landfill and therefore cannot be placed at the curb for pickup. This includes televisions, computer monitors/accessories, DVD/VCR players, as well as several other items. For a complete list of banned items, and where to properly dispose of these items, contact Republic Services.

Reminders:

- This bulk pick up is at the curb only, not in alleys.
- Any items that are not "stand alone" items must be contained in bags and can't exceed 50 lbs.
- Items placed in cardboard boxes will not be picked up
