

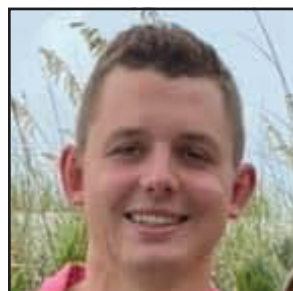
Board of Director's Candidates
